We will be working on some fun Thanksgiving activities—

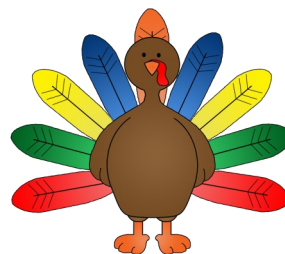
We will be:
